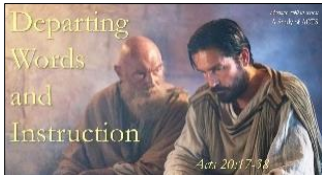

Departing Words and Instruction

Acts 20:17-38



In our passage today we find Paul saying goodbye to his friends from Ephesus. He was on his way to Jerusalem for possibly the feast of Pentecost. Paul and his friends, carrying an offering for the church in Jerusalem, are most likely traveling on a merchant ship. They make several stops along the way and one of those stops is at the town of Miletus. When it appeared that there would be a several day delay, Paul sent for the leaders of the church in nearby Ephesus, so he could say farewell. Notice Paul's love and compassion as he spoke in this passage and how he offered instruction on how to lead God's people.
